Ed is very active in our community with several charities. He serves as Treasurer for Pleasantview Industries, a program for adults with developmental disabilities.

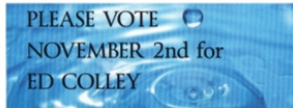


Ed Colley's promises kept:
